National Seeds Corporation Limited (NSC) desires to produce about 60000 Qtls. (Paddy Jyothi 5000 Qtl, Groundnut TMV-2 38500 Qtl, GPBD-4 3500 Qtls, ICGV-19114 – 1000 Qtls, Kadari – 6- 2000 Qtls and Fodder Maize African Tall – 10000 Qtls) certified seed through production programme, Kharif 2011 and for marketing during Rabi 2011-12. Duly packed and certified in NSC bags from reputed seed producers / organizers hereinafter called the **Seed Organizer**, Interested Organizer may submit their offer in two prescribed formats – A & B enclosed herewith.

**TWO BID SYSTEM :**

A. Two independent sealed envelopes should be prepared as detailed below :

**1. ENVELOPE NO.1 (SEALED) :**

This envelop should be marked as “ENVELOPE NO.1 – TECHNICAL BID for SUPPLY OF Paddy Jyothi /Groundnut TMV-2/GPBD-4/ICGV-91114/Kadari-6/Fodder Maize African Tall certified seed and should contain following papers with covering letter on letter head (Organizer should invariably mention their name, address etc. on left hand side of envelop for clear identification)

- a. PART “A” (Technical Bid)
- b. Security Money: Details.

**2. ENVELOPE NO. 2 (SEALED) :**

This envelope should be marked as ENVELOPE NO. 2 –FINANCIAL BID (EOI Offer) for supply of Paddy, Groundnut and Fodder Maize CS and should contain PART “B”. (Organiser should invariably mention their name, Address etc. on left hand side of envelop for clear identification) and should quote their minimum service charge acceptable to them.

3. Both the envelopes should be enclosed in one big sealed envelope super scribing “EOI FOR / SEED ORGANIZER KPH.2011. The sealed tender should be delivered in the office of the **REGIONAL MANAGER, NSC, UAS CAMPUS, HEBBAL, BANGALORE** upto **3.00 P.M dated 25.5.2011.**

4. Tenderer must affix seal and put address on each envelop.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ORGANISING CERTIFIED SEED PRODUCTION PROGRAMME THROUGH ORGANISERS DURING KHARIF 2011 IN THE STATE OF KARNATAKA**

**Eligibility :** Reputed Private seed producer, Govt. Agency, Co-operative Societies having vast net work of seed production in Karnataka and has own Registered Seed Processing Plant & has valid Seed License for the seed handling & business can participate in the deal.

**NSC wants to produce following certified seeds through organizers during Kharif 2011 in Karnataka State.**

- The terms and conditions stated below shall be binding on the parties and their relationship shall be governed by these terms and conditions.
- The organizer will produce Certified Seeds on the behalf of NSC as assigned to him. The organizer shall deposit all charges to KSSCA regarding the seed certification and arrange registration of the seeds.
- The organizer will arrange planting material at their own cost and utilize Foundation Seeds or C/S –I of different crop varieties entered into agreement and also arrange verification of source at the designated KSSCA offices. However if the planting material is available with NSC that can be supplied to the organizer at NSC rate
  - The organizer shall arrange field inspection of seed plots by KSSCA technical staff as and when required.
  - The organizer shall also arrange field inspection of seed plots to be carried out randomly by technical staff of NSC as and when informed to maintain quality at field stage post harvesting stage.
  - The organizer as advised by technical officers of KSSCA/NSC at seed processing level, shall carry out all such operations (roughing etc.) required at field level in order to maintain quality of seed.
  - The organizer shall arrange sealing and sampling of produce from the seed plots declared meeting field standards by KSSCA & NSC within the stipulated time to be declared by KSSCA.
  - The organizer shall in advance designate the processing plant where grading & packing is to be taken up & sealed produce to be stocked there, the designated plant must be registered with KSSCA. The grading and packing of seed will be done by organizer at his cost.
  - NSC, may draw samples randomly from the stocked / sealed produce for its testing at quality control laboratories of NSC. If any lot observed substandard by QCL, NSC will reject the lot of the seed and refuse to accept such seeds.

11. The organizer will lift packing & treatment material from the nearest NSC office. i.e. Cloth Bags, Jute / HDPE Bags / Labels, Thread Spools, Lead seals / Treatment Material and secondary packing material, if any. The organizer should submit utilization certificate of the packing material along with their bills.
12. The organizer on receipt of standard results from QCL & STL Labs, after grading, shall arrange treatment & packing of seed in desired packing size & inform NSC for inspection of grading & packing of the seeds.
13. The organizer under normal circumstances is bound to supply the agreed quantity duly tested and packed Certified seed to NSC in NSC packing of following crops by the due date indicated below

- i.e. Delivery of total agreed quantity in 30 days = Quantity per day i.e. 3.33 % per day of the agreed quantity.
14. In case of delay, penalty @ 0.5 % of the cost / day will be deducted from the payment of the organizer for delayed quantity. In case of unavoidable circumstances, RM may relax it on providing written request with sound reasoning.
  15. NSC shall lift the seed from the organizers premises within 30 days from the notice of completing of packing.
  16. NSC would release payment to the organizer after 30 days of lifting of seed, after submission of all documents. Procurement rate would be **at par KSSC + agreed service charges.**
  17. The organizer would submit the bill alongwith copies of original challan of the delivery of seeds to NSC, duly signed, alongwith release orders of KSSCA. After lifting of packed seed, NSC will release 90 % payment of the seed received (in case no advance is paid earlier)
  18. The organizer has to deliver unused packing & treatment material at the NSC's nearest processing plant immediately, with statement of accounts of used / unused packing / treatment material.

19. NSC is free to reject any field plot, seed lot in case at any stage if any lapses observed in the parameters of seed production and certification, the deal can be cancelled with issue of notice.
20. The service tax, Income Tax or if any , would be borne by the organizer.
21. NSC shall be free to impose penalty or stop final payment in case there is any complaint about the quality of the seed received within 30 days from consignee destination of NSC.
22. The contract is quantity oriented with 5 % variation on higher or lower side.
23. NSC shall have neither commitment / responsibility of payment to the individual growers whose list has been submitted by the organizer nor shall NSC be responsible for any loss to the organizer during the entire process of the deal. NSC will deal with organizer (main grower only)
24. NSC will procure duly processed, tested and packed seed in the desired NSC packing size. The seed should be standard as per MSCS 1988 standard and amendment from time to time.
25. Balance 10 % payment will be released after successful completion of the deal.
26. In case, organizer fails to deliver seed whatsoever committed, EMD may be forfeited and no correspondence to this effect would be entertained.
27. In case any party fails to deliver full quantity of Certified Seed to NSC, as agreed, penalty @ 5 % towards compensation of the total value for short supply will be imposed on the organizer.
28. Organizer has to deposit security of Rs.50,000/- along with the EOI offer.
29. Job order for production of seed on behalf NSC will be issued after depositing 2% of EMD of the total value of the agreed quantity of the seed production. The Security deposit will be adjusted in the EMD. The EMD can be refunded without interest after successful execution of the deal.
30. Party has no right to claim the order on the basis of lowest service charge rate offered by them. The job order will be issued rationally, by considering the production capacity, capability and infrastructure availability experience etc., of the organizer. R.M reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EIO offers without assigning any reason whatsoever.
31. In the event of any dispute or difference arising under or in connection with this Agreement, in implementation, or its satisfaction, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator, who may be appointed by the Chairman-cum-Managing Director of NSC, or by any other officer who at the relevant time is occupying the highest office in NSC and decision of the arbitrator will be acceptable to both and abide by them.
